 **Restore Britain**

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1/Reverse Mass Migration.

Mass immigration has been a disaster for Britain. It has left us poorer, less safe, and less culturally and socially cohesive. By 2030 native British births will account for fewer than 50% of total births in Britain. By 2070, native Brits will be an absolute minority.

In order to avert this, Restore Britain will reverse mass immigration. If a legally resident foreign national is unable to speak English, lives in social housing, claims benefits, refuses to work, fails to integrate, commits crime or actively hates our way of life and wishes to do us harm, they will be deported. All state benefits will be withdrawn from foreign nationals and British citizenship will be redefined so that it is far more difficult to obtain. If an individual surrenders his second citizenship in an attempt to fraudulently remain in Britain, we will take the necessary steps to reverse that process and deport them. If that means millions go, then millions go.

The so-called 'Boriswave' in particular must be undone.

The British people never wanted mass immigration. Restore Britain won't just end it – we will reverse it.

Deport All Illegal Migrants.

In 2025, 41,472 illegal migrants – the overwhelming majority of whom were adult males – crossed the channel illegally. Many are housed at the taxpayer's expense, and some have gone on to commit heinous

crimes including rape and murder. By the end of the decade, this policy will have cost the taxpayer over £15 billion.

Our research suggests that there are up to 2 million illegal migrants in Britain today. This is unacceptable and unsafe. every single one must be deported.

Restore Britain will remove all legal obstacles – such as easily-exploited “human rights” laws – and implement the most ambitious programme of mass deportations ever seen in Britain.

This is not extreme – it is necessary for public safety and national security.

Introduce the Red List.

Nationals from designated Red List countries will face far stricter security checks, limited visa categories, and higher barriers to entry.

A security-led review to assess countries based on crime statistics, cultural attitudes, sexual offences, extremism risk, visa overstayers, integration failure, and foreign policy hostility will run regularly.

Any country that refuses to take back its foreign national offenders or illegal migrants will be added to the red list and face visa suspensions, remittance taxes, aid cancellation, and formal diplomatic pressure.

Nations that are proven to supply us with sex pests, criminals and rapists will also be added.

Candidates for appearance on our red list would include Pakistan, India, Afghanistan, Eritrea, Sudan, and Syria, among others.

Abolish the Asylum System

Britain is a Christian nation and having an asylum system is a noble goal. However, the one that currently exists here has been so thoroughly abused and undermined that it is no longer fit for purpose, and must be abolished in its entirety.

Furthermore, Britain does not have the money or space to accommodate the destitute of the world at this moment. We have more than enough problems of our own to solve before we even consider taking on thousands more dependents.

The British people must come first.

Use Tents, Not Hotels

Establish modular, tent-based holding facilities for so-called “asylum seekers”. These will comply with basic humanitarian standards (e.g. shelter, sanitation, medical triage), but will be deliberately austere and designed for short-term containment.

Land owned by the Ministry of Defence, or other government bodies will be repurposed for the establishment of temporary accommodation facilities. Planning restrictions will be bypassed using emergency statutory instruments under public protection and border security provisions.

All illegal entrants housed in these facilities will be subject to mandatory administrative detention pending deportation. No illegal migrant will be granted bail into the community. The policy will make clear: if you arrive illegally, you are detained until you are deported.

Illegal entrants will be declared inadmissible to the UK and removed

back to where they came from, or to a designated third country.

End All Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) Benefits.

Indefinite Leave to Remain is a legal status that, in its current form, gives immigrants free access to benefits and the NHS.

It also serves as a de facto pathway to citizenship.

The Centre for Policy Studies reckons that more than 800,000 recent immigrants will become eligible for benefits by the end of this decade, costing the taxpayer £234bn over the course of these migrants' lifetimes.

ILR must be overhauled. This will boost emigration, easing pressure on public services and housing. These changes must be applied to those already here.

Non-citizens should only be in Britain on strict, time-limited terms that are conditional on work, tax contribution, and good character.

A Restore Britain government would cancel all of ILR's associated benefits. Funds for foreign nationals who wish to return home as a result of an end to such benefits ought to be made available. In the long run, this scheme would be far cheaper than allowing them to stay.

The only remaining perk associated with ILR status would be indefinite residency along the lines enjoyed by British expatriates in places like Dubai. This status would be easily revocable on our terms at any time.

Strip citizenship from those wrongly handed such papers by a treacherous political establishment.

If ever revoking a dual national's citizenship papers is in the interests of the British people and consistent with existing laws around denaturalisation, we would pursue that course of action without delay.

For instance, we would find Alaa Abd El-Fattah, revoke his British citizenship, and send him home.

The same fate would befall many just like him.

Deport Rape Gang Collaborators.

Any non-British national who knowingly covered up or enabled rape gang abuse, even through silence, must face automatic deportation. Turning a blind eye to evil makes you complicit.

If a foreign national mother, sister, or wife knew about the abuse and failed to report it, they will be treated as accessories and stripped of any right to remain in the UK.

Legislate to allow the revocation of British citizenship from dual nationals where individuals have protected rape gang offenders in their family.

Cultural 'excuses', community 'pressure', or religion must never be a defence. Our priority is to protect vulnerable British girls - not those who shield and enable abusers.

Introduce Fairer, Discerning Spousal

Visas.

For citizens of countries not on the Red List, spousal visa applications should be simplified and fast-tracked, with clear criteria and quicker decisions for genuine relationships.

Applicants need to demonstrate English fluency, commitment to Britain, and the ability to support themselves. We should be rewarding self-reliant family formation, not adding public charges to the welfare bill.

By being tough where it matters, we can be fair and generous where it counts, supporting British citizens who want to build a family with their foreign spouse.

In short, we would make life harder for foreign benefit scroungers and illegal migrants, not for the law-abiding husbands and wives of British citizens.

Deport Foreign Criminals.

For a Briton to commit a crime is of course wrong, but for a foreign national to commit a crime is both wrong and an abuse of hospitality.

In particular, any non-British or dual national who knowingly covered up or enabled rape gang abuse – even through silence – would face deportation under a Restore Britain government.

If a foreign national mother, sister, or wife knew about the abuse and failed to report it, they should be treated as accessories and denied any right to remain in Britain.

Cultural excuses, community pressure, or religious objection must never be a defence. Our priority is to protect vulnerable British girls,

not those who shield and enable abusers.

We see no reason why this should not also apply to lesser crimes, be it fraud or fly-tipping. The fact that plenty of our own people misbehave at times is no reason to tolerate the presence of other nations' troublemakers.

Fix the Afghan Disgrace.

Every Afghan national brought to Britain under emergency schemes will be subject to removal and relocation to a safe third country. Britain gave temporary refuge, not a permanent home.

A Restore Britain government would work with safe third countries to relocate Afghan nationals regionally – closer to home, culturally compatible, and logistically sustainable. Britain cannot serve as a permanent home for anyone in the world claiming hardship.

Any senior civil servant or government official involved in the leak or cover up must face job termination or prosecution.

We would also legislate to prevent super-injunctions from being used to shield political embarrassment, immigration failures, or straightforward criminality.

Ban Election Campaigning in Foreign Languages.

Two simple measures would see to this.

First, we would ban foreign nationals, including commonwealth citizens, from voting in our elections.

Second, if a foreign national living in Britain cannot speak English,

they would be removed in any case.

2/ Reward the Nation's Grafters, Protect the Nation's Vulnerable.

Britain's economy rewards both indolence and greed whilst punishing prudence. It is increasingly difficult for honest, hardworking people to build a life here, because any wealth they generate is brutally taxed.

At best, their money is used to fund schemes that do not benefit them or their families in any way; at worst, it is simply wasted, as Rupert Lowe's work on the Public Accounts Committee has shown. Public-sector procurement is inefficient, accounts are in disarray, and fraud is widespread.

Reversing this decline will require difficult decisions, but we are prepared to make them. We will transform Britain's economy into one that rewards those who work hard and take risks, whilst providing a robust social safety net that genuinely protects the nation's most vulnerable – not healthy shirkers.

This will mean ending government waste, ending foreign aid, ending benefits for foreign nationals, and getting healthy Brits off of benefits and into work.

Scrap IR35.

IR35 treats independent contractors like employees for tax purposes, but without giving them any of the rights.

Freelancers, start-ups, and small businesses thrive on flexibility. IR35 strangles that with bureaucracy and confusion, holding back enterprise and job creation.

The self-employed keep Britain running. IR35 drives them away from contracts, out of work, or even overseas. A Restore Britain government would scrap IR35 to restore fairness.

Abolish Inheritance Tax (IHT).

IHT undermines the right to pass on wealth to one's children, penalising those who save, invest, and build businesses by taxing assets that were already taxed during the owner's lifetime.

At times, IHT forces heirs to sell family businesses, farms, or property to meet this punitive death tax, disrupting long-term stewardship and the local economy.

IHT is rooted in an envy-based philosophy of wealth redistribution. It expands state power at the expense of individual freedom.

As social beings with deeply felt inter-generational bonds, we work not just for ourselves, but for the good of our families, living as well as unborn.

A civilisation that treats its own offspring as no better than random strangers, entitled to nothing but the right to start again from scratch, has become corrupt.

A Restore Britain government would abolish IHT.

Establish the Lowest Corporation Tax in Europe.

We would slash the corporation tax rate to the lowest in Europe.

Entrepreneurs, risk-takers, and innovators should be welcome in Britain. The move would attract investment, retain growing British companies, and reverse the trend of businesses relocating abroad.

Replace the bloated, loophole-riddled system with a simple, flat, low rate – clear, fair, and competitive. Introduce tax holidays for new small businesses to give them the breathing space needed to get off the ground.

We would offer additional deductions or incentives to companies that invest in domestic manufacturing, research, training, and infrastructure.

Ireland has proved that lower rates do not mean lower revenue. The most effective way to maximise tax revenue is to generate as much wealth as possible, allowing for a robust and affordable social safety net.

Tax Remittances to Foreign Countries.

Britain must stop being treated as a cashpoint for the rest of the world. Every year, billions of pounds are sent abroad in remittances – money earned here, but drained out of our economy to support families and communities overseas.

This encourages mass immigration. The vast majority of third-worlders come not to contribute to Britain, as our leaders insist, but to extract wealth and send it abroad.

A levy on remittances would disincentivise such shenanigans, discouraging economic migration and pressuring those already here for the purposes of wealth extraction to return home.

Foreign nationals must be forced to respect the rules of the host. While here, their duty is to Britain, not to foreign states, overseas families, or criminal networks abroad.

Get Able-bodied Britons on Benefits Back to Work.

Work would include picking litter, wiping away graffiti, and clearing drains. Anyone who refuses or slacks on the job would be denied their benefits.

Too many Britons of working age are living on the backs of honest tax payers. We want a society that looks after the most vulnerable, but not a back-to-front system of incentives that rewards shirkers.

Restore the British High Street.

Establish a new multi-agency unit to investigate suspicious businesses - particularly cash-heavy, clone-like chains of barbers, vape shops, dessert cafes, and phone repair stalls with unclear ownership and inconsistent trading.

Focus on those with no real footfall, high turnover, or known links to organised crime, visa overstays, or laundering.

Work with immigration enforcement to review schemes used to open front businesses - often as a cover for illegal immigration or modern slavery.

HMRC to conduct routine tax compliance audits on certain business categories with known abuse potential.

Immigration enforcement should be empowered to investigate suspicious businesses and foreign beggars - deporting those who are here illegally.

3/ Put British Interests First.

Too many within the British political establishment are more interested in serving the world, international institutions, or foreign states than pursuing our own national interest. A Restore Britain government would bring this globalist approach to a resounding end.

On everything from military aid to the deployment of our armed forces, the interests of the British people would forever be our solemn priority.

We agree with the 19th century statesman Lord Palmerston, who once declared: “We have no eternal allies, and we have no perpetual enemies. Our interests are eternal and perpetual, and those interests

it is our duty to follow.”

All forms of foreign aid that do nothing to advance Britain’s national interests in the world would be scrapped.

Rebuild and rearm Britain. We will have a big stick, and we will wave it whenever we see fit to do so.

End DEI within Britain’s armed forces.

A Restore Britain government would abolish every trace of DEI across all government departments. Nowhere does this matter more than within the Ministry of Defence.

Recently, it emerged that Andrew Harwin, an RAF squadron leader, instructed staff back in 2021 to stop selecting “useless white male pilots” for training courses. This was not an isolated scandal. In 2022, it became undeniable that under Sir Mike Wigston, who has since resigned, the RAF actively discriminated against white men – a self-defeating crusade for which the new head of the force, Sir Richard Knighton, later apologised. Nevertheless, DEI targets remain in place.

The British army, tasked with the urgent duty of defending the realm, has shrunk by 40% since 2010. We now boast a mere 70,000 enlisted soldiers.

At Restore Britain, we believe that success in battle is not only a matter of how well a man can fight, but what he is willing to fight for. The most fearsome soldier in the world is not only worthless but harmful if his loyalties commit him to siding with the enemy.

As well as a powerhouse of soldierly talent, the British army should be a place for young men to live out their sense of duty to their own

people. In Britain, that will mean focussing recruitment efforts on the native majority.

This occurs in almost every other nation on the planet, because it is a more reliable way to fill depleted ranks than fishing for minorities who may be commendable as individuals, but whose roots here will be shallow by comparison and their ties to Britain relatively weak.

4/Infrastructure, and Energy Security.

Rebuild Britain's Industry, Infrastructure, and Energy Security.

We should not be plowing up and paving over the glorious British countryside to make way for endless, generic, low-quality housing developments.

Britain doesn't have a housing crisis - it has a population crisis. Our immigration policies will drastically reduce the pressure on the housing market and make it far easier for young families to own their own homes without needing to build thousands of new houses.

Make Energy Cheap, Reliable, and Scalable.

Energy is the lifeblood of any developed first-world economy.

First and foremost, then, it should be cheap, reliable, and scalable.

If that means investment in fossil fuels, so be it.

Affordable energy makes nations rich. Rich nations are better equipped to tackle any environmental challenges.

Repeal Net Zero Goals.

For too long, the British state has put luxury beliefs around Net Zero before the critical energy needs of the British people.

The Climate Change Act (2008), expanded to devastating effect by Theresa May in 2019, should be abolished.

The countries that have gambled most heavily on renewables, such as Germany, Denmark, and indeed Britain, have some of the highest energy prices in the world.

Pursue a Britain First Energy Security Strategy.

In the modern world, national sovereignty means next to nothing if it is not backed by energy independence.

No foreign power should own any component of our energy infrastructure. We cannot afford to be held to ransom by forces beyond our immediate control.

Britain is sitting on an energy goldmine. Lifting the ban on North Sea oil and gas exploration must be a priority and the opportunities presented by shale gas must be re-examined.

Implement an Infrastructure First Housing Policy.

Developers would be required to fund local infrastructure in the area before a shovel goes in the ground. British homes for British families.

Infrastructure projects would focus on our needs here at home.

Reclaim Our Fisheries.

A Restore Britain government would take back our seas and take back our fish.

End Hosepipe Bans.

A wealthy and famously rainy country should never run out of water. Prioritise the construction of new reservoirs across water-stressed regions to boost national water storage capacity.

Cut red tape and accelerate planning approvals for reservoirs, pipelines, and water transfer schemes to ensure swift delivery.

Implement a net negative immigration system to reduce demand. Ensure a growing supply to meet a shrinking demand. No more hosepipe bans.

Hold water firms legally accountable with strict, time-bound targets to cut leakage - backed by severe fines for failure and incentives for early delivery.

Automate the Tube.

London's Tube drivers are among the highest-paid in the world, taking home over £60,000 a year for a role that is increasingly obsolete. Yet every year, militant unions bring the capital to a standstill with strikes, causing massive disruption.

Driverless trains already operate safely in Paris, Singapore, Dubai, and even on parts of London's own network (the DLR). The technology exists, and it works. Why is Britain not using it?

Automation would cut costs, improve reliability, and ensure Londoners are never again held hostage by transport unions. The Tube should exist to serve the people of London, not the narrow interests of a well-paid union clique.

5/ Restore Britain's Social and Cultural Foundations.

Put Pro-family Policy at the Heart of Everything We Do.

If British families want to have more children, we will not hesitate to use the power of the state to enable that, not least by making childcare more accessible and more affordable.

A limited number of days for a term-time holiday for well-developed children. In the main, we would trust parents to make the best decisions for their families.

Reform family courts, so that good fathers and mothers are not kept away from their children for malicious reasons.

Restore our Town Centres.

Business rates for small businesses abolished. Turkish barbers, vape shops, and other suspicious businesses investigated. Graffiti cleaned, litter picked. Pavements fixed. Free parking in select areas to drive back footfall from retail

car parks and back into our town centres

We will make Britain clean again, and we will take pride in our communities again.

Defund the Rotten BBC.

Make it a subscription service and let it wither on the vine.

Repeal the Assisted Dying Bill and Reverse Recent Changes Made to Decriminalise Abortion up to Birth.

Assisted dying and abortion up to birth are symptoms of a society that has given up on itself.

Both target the most vulnerable demographics in our society - the sick, the elderly, and the unborn.

Restore Britain would repeal the assisted dying bill and reverse the changes that permit abortion up to birth.

Churches to Receive Equal Access to Security and Safeguarding Support Where Justified by Evidence.

Recognising that Britain's churches are not only places of worship but central pillars of our national heritage, we would create a National Churches & Christian Heritage Restoration Fund.

This fund would preserve historic church buildings, protect architectural landmarks, and support rural and urban communities that rely on them as cultural anchors.

We would also pass targeted planning legislation, designed to prevent disused

churches from being turned into mosques or otherwise dishonoured.

A Restore Britain government would strengthen the teaching of our Christian heritage within national curriculum history modules.

British Christians now have a political party that represents their views and stands ready to act on them. We are an historically Christian country, guided by Christian morality.

A Restore Britain government would honour those moral traditions.

We would do this not for the purposes of religious instruction so much as historical literacy.

The influence of Christianity on Britain's legal system, literature, art, culture, architecture, and institutions is foundational to understanding our national story.

Ban the Burqa.

Both the burqa and the niqab are fundamentally un-British and have no place on our high streets.

Countries across Europe, including France, Belgium, and Austria, have already banned the burqa.

The dignity of women and girls must not be sacrificed on the altar of multiculturalism.

An overwhelming majority of Britons back a ban.

A Restore Britain government would reverse the Islamisation of Britain.

Ban Halal and Kosher Slaughter.

Slitting an animal's throat and letting it bleed to death in the most unimaginable pain is morally repugnant.

We must not bend our standards to accommodate cruel religious practices that would otherwise be unlawful.

If a British farmer treated an animal in this way, he would be prosecuted. There must be one rule for all, with no religious exemptions.

Sex is Biological.

Biological sex is not a social construct. It is a fixed trait, determined by genetics and encoded in every cell of the human body.

Men and women are morally equal, but not physically identical. These differences must be acknowledged, respected, and allowed to inform law-making.

Men must not be permitted to enter women-only spaces, including lavatories, prisons, and sporting contests. Anything less puts women and girls at risk.

Objective truth, not ideology, must guide governance.

In view of these principles, the Gender Recognition Act must be repealed. The state must no longer issue legal documents that permit individuals to change their sex in law. Biological sex will be recognised as immutable and recorded accordingly.

6/ Make Britain Safe Again

No-nonsense policing that does what it needs to do.

Widespread stop and search back.

Accusations of racism will stop nothing, up to and including strict sentences for anyone caught carrying a knife.

Hold a Binding Referendum on Restoring the Death Penalty.

Axel Rudakubana, the Southport murderer, and Hashem Abedi, responsible for the Manchester Arena bombing, have both assaulted prison officers while behind bars.

A considerable majority of the country supports the death penalty for certain crimes, not least because a prison cell for a murderer costs us over £55,000 per year.

It is just to execute those guilty of the most heinous crimes. Exceptional circumstances demand exceptional measures.

The British people must be given a say.

Legalise Pepper Spray.

British women face an increasing threat of physical and sexual violence, primarily due to mass legal and illegal immigration.

Police forces seem either unable or unwilling to uphold the law and protect those most vulnerable from the most heinous crimes. As such, women must have the ability to adequately defend themselves.

The right to self-defence must not be infringed. Women should be permitted to carry and use pepper spray – a tool used by the police themselves – to defend against attackers.

Those who care for the defence of innocent life and the state of the law deserve every possible advantage against criminals who care for

neither.

Crush the Rape Gangs.

We would embark on a national strategy, working from the findings of our rape gang inquiry, to tackle and decapitate the national crime network of primarily Pakistani muslim sexual slavery, torture, and murder.

Mandate CCTV in Taxis.

Since at least the early 1990s, evidence shows that taxis and private hire vehicles have been used by foreign criminal gangs for drug trafficking, money laundering, and the sexual exploitation of young girls.

Mandatory CCTV in every taxi, funded by councils, must be implemented to deter this type of behaviour.

Hired transport should be a place of safety – but according to research by the Suzy Lamplugh Trust, regulatory loopholes have allowed hundreds of individuals with criminal convictions to acquire licenses.

Women across the country report inappropriate conduct by taxi and PHV drivers.

Ban Islamist Hate-preaching.

Any mosque found to be preaching extreme doctrine must be shut down.

Hateful Islamist organisations must be identified and proscribed, and deprived of any taxpayer funding.

Gulf states such as the UAE warn that Britain has become a breeding ground for Islamic extremism. This poses an immediate threat to national security, and radicalisation must be cut off at source.

Pass Shamima's Law, revoking right to remain and stripping citizenship from dual-national Islamic extremists. Ban entry of foreign hate preachers, and deport those who are already here.

Investigate Food Delivery Companies.

The "gig economy" – and food delivery platforms in particular – has become a major pull factor for illegal migration to the United Kingdom. This is an internationally recognised problem – even Emmanuel Macron commented on it during negotiations with the British Government over illegal migration.

An investigation by The Telegraph revealed that illegal migrants housed in Home Office hotels are working illegally as bike couriers for Deliveroo, Just Eat, and Uber Eats, making up to £500 a week. Many are banned from working but use rented or fake courier accounts, paying up to £100 a week on the black market, while sharing illegal e-bikes to deliver food. This illegal work is used to repay debts to people smugglers, with money wired abroad to cover the cost of small boat crossings. Smugglers openly advertise Britain as the easiest place to earn money illegally.

These companies appear to benefit from this arrangement. Uber Eats, for example, has admitted that a Government crackdown on illegal workers will drive up the cost of takeaways

This cannot continue. Companies operating in this grey area of the economy must be held to account for their role in encouraging illegal migration by enabling those here illegally to work. A full investigation

must be launched, and if it is proven that these firms have knowingly profited from illegal labour, criminal charges must follow. If this puts them out of business, so be it.

7/ Restore the NHS as a NATIONAL health service.

The NHS must serve the British people as its first and only priority. We will accept ultra-high skilled migrants to work within our healthcare system, but we will not support millions of low-skilled migrants who contribute nothing yet take so much.

Free car parking for NHS staff, patients, and visitors on tight permits.

Medical school caps will be demolished. We would allow talented young British men and women to train in medicine. The NHS will then be forced to employ them over foreign staff.

8/ Restore Civil Liberties.

Repeal the Online Safety Act.

Platforms hosting lawful content must be shielded from government pressure to censor. We would require transparency in content moderation and prohibit state-directed takedowns of legal speech.

The Online Safety Act law threatens the integrity of investigative journalism, whistleblowing, and political debate.

Fears of liability lead to over-moderation, driving smaller players out of the market and empowering Big Tech.

A Restore Britain government would therefore repeal the Online Safety Act. Any Labour VPN ban would also be immediately reversed.

Reverse as Much of the Lockdown Legacy as Possible.

A Restore Britain government would quash all convictions for non-violent breaches of lockdown rules (e.g. leaving home, attending protests, running a business). We would ensure that no one has a criminal record for breaking laws that should never have existed.

We would make targeted changes to Britain's 'state of emergency' legislation in order to render future lockdowns near-impossible.

Lockdowns took an especially devastating toll on the flourishing and prospects of young people, who deserve to be compensated in some form. It is beyond the wit of any government to reverse all of the damage inflicted by a near-total freeze of society and a spree of mass money printing, but as much of that damage as possible must be reversed.

Last of all, there should be an independent review of SAGE predictions and data used to justify lockdowns, complete with unredacted access to all relevant modelling and communications.

Launch an Independent Inquiry into COVID-19 Vaccines.

We would establish a truly independent inquiry into the safety, rollout, and long-term effects of the COVID-19 vaccines, especially on

young people and those coerced into taking them.

Thousands of people have suffered serious side effects, some permanently. We would overhaul the Vaccine Damage Payment Scheme, increase payouts, and speed up claims. Proper compensation must be provided to the families of those who lost their lives due to the vaccine.

A Restore Britain government would publish all relevant communications from politicians and 'experts' that led to the mass vaccine rollout and vaccine passports. Politicians like Reform UK's Nadhim Zahawi will be forced to appear before an independent commission to be questioned on their actions during lockdown.

Restore the Right to Self-defence.

Law-abiding citizens must have the full legal right to use reasonable force – including lethal force if necessary – to protect their home, family, and property from illegal intruders without fear of prosecution.

Self-defence protections must apply wherever you are fairly protecting yourself, your family, or your property.

Legal ambiguity must be dispelled. The law should respect decisive action in moments of fear, not presume to judge split-second reactions with hindsight.

We must re-affirm the so-called castle doctrine: your home is your sanctuary, so you have the right to defend it.

Block the Introduction of Digital ID.

Digital ID is the policy of a low-trust, fragmented society. It is not in

the interests of the British people or in keeping with our long-standing traditions for the state to have such an excessive level of involvement in the day-to-day business of citizens.

Digital ID opens the door to other anti-freedom policies such as Chinese-style surveillance, a social credit system, and central bank digital currency.

Digital ID is presented as a solution to issues like illegal immigration, but if the problem were tackled at source rather than treating the symptoms, such an ID would be unnecessary.

Laws must be passed to prevent the introduction of compulsory digital ID. Once it is imposed, there is no going back.

Revive Britain's Finest Free Speech Traditions.

In Britain, our finest free speech traditions have effectively been eroded by invasive modern statutes. We used to rank alongside the United States, which took its own free speech traditions from us, as among the freest countries in the world. That status has given way to a culture of safetyism and censorship.

A Restore Britain government would place our finest free speech traditions on a strong statutory footing, guaranteeing that lawful expression cannot be criminalised or censored by the state or private platforms.

This should be done in tandem with a thoroughgoing attack on existing anti-free speech laws – a problem that goes as far back as at least the 1960s, with the birth of “hate speech” and “incitement to hatred” laws.

Our common law traditions around speech have always erred on the side of freedom. Boundaries are essential. Without them, civilisations collapse.

However, the boundaries on speech in Britain today are excessive, ideologically motivated, unfairly applied, and do not protect the interests of the British people.

The laws infringing on free speech must be repealed and new ones passed that restore Britain's finest free speech traditions.

9/ Restore a Pro-British Education System.

Deliver an Education System That Teaches, Respects, and Celebrates British History and Equips Students with Practical Skills.

A Restore Britain government would encourage and fund youngsters to take up apprenticeships and learn a proper skill instead of some bogus university degree.

It is important that less academically inclined children at school are able to learn life skills that they will actually need in modern society.

End School Holiday Fines

Families should have the freedom to take children on meaningful trips inside term time without being fined by the state, for up to five school days a year.

Parents should be trusted to act in the interests of their own children. Five days a year will not ruin their education, but it will give children irreplaceable life experience that cannot be gained in the classroom.

Many families can only afford holidays in term time. The current system punishes those who work hard but can't pay school holiday premiums.

It is not the business of the state to micromanage family life.

Restore the University

Britain is home to some of the world's oldest and most prestigious universities. We should be setting global standards in research and academic excellence – but instead of pursuing truth, our high-culture institutions have been totally captured by anti-British, anti-Western, and anti-white ideological trends such as decolonisation, intersectionality, and critical race theory.

This does not serve the interests of the British public. In fact, it is in academia that so many of the destructive ideas that have come to dominate our culture and political life originate, from gender ideology to multiculturalism.

There is no such thing as a neutral institution – and this goes for education. Our universities should be openly pro-British: proud of

our history, proud of our culture, proud of our people.

We should not be afraid of rooting out subversive elements within our education system. Professors and administrative staff pushing anti-British ideology should hold no position in a publicly funded British university. Courses that brainwash students into hating their own culture should be shut down. In the most egregious cases, inquiries pertaining to entire universities must be held.

10/ Safeguard Election Integrity.

End Political Islam and Other Forms of Ethnoreligious Bloc Voting.

Too many parties complain about the inevitable electoral consequences of the fragmented demographics caused by mass migration, but lack the courage to do anything about it.

If we gain power, we will address this festering problem once and for all.

Postal voting will be abolished, save for those in genuine, proven need.

A full review into past irregularities would be launched, together with prosecutions for any historic wrongdoing. If a foreign or dual national is found guilty, they will be deported.

No foreign national would ever be permitted to vote or stand in a British election, be it local, regional, or national.

We commit to restoring British elections for British people.

Abolish Mass Postal Voting.

Postal voting on demand has made our elections vulnerable to fraud, coercion, and manipulation. Voting should be a serious act, done in person, at a polling station, with full supervision.

Postal votes must be reserved for those who are genuinely housebound or abroad for official reasons (e.g. military or diplomatic service). These must be individually verified, security-checked applications. Proxy voting may be allowed under strict regulation.

Launch a full review into previous allegations of postal vote fraud, particularly in areas with repeated irregularities. Those found to have manipulated ballots, intimidated voters, or exploited vulnerable communities will face criminal prosecution/deportation if foreign.

The British public must have confidence that elections are free, fair, and secure. That starts with ending the system most open to abuse. Restore trust by abolishing mass postal voting.
